Some numbers...

- Total volunteer economic contribution for **Australia >\$290 billion**
- In SA, volunteer economic contribution is **>\$5 billion**
- **6.1 million** of Australians over the age of 18 volunteer
- Just under **1 million** South Australians volunteer
- There are, on average, **5** volunteers for every paid worker



Articulating value

- Wider benefits to the community – what difference does the volunteering make?
- Costs of volunteering – e.g. management
